- Our results in reading 80% are higher than the local authority (LA) 72% and national 73%.
- Our results in writing 87% are higher than the LA 78% and national 78%.
- Our results in mathematics 93% are higher than the LA 80% and national 79%.
- Children with pupil premium make comparable progress with non PP children. Only one child with PP did not achieve ARE in writing, mathematics and GPS.

- Our results in reading 79% are higher than the LA 75% and national 75%.
- Our results in mathematics 79% are higher than the LA 76% and national 76%.
- Our results in writing 68% are comparable with the LA 71% and national 69%.
- Children with pupil premium and EAL did better than non-pupil premium pupils in reading, writing and mathematics.
- More pupils achieved greater depth in mathematics in Year 2 that in Newcastle (23%) and national results (22%).

Phonics - 81% achieved the Y1 phonic check (LA 80.5, National 81.9).

Early Years - Reception- cohort 11

- **82%** of children (9/11) achieved the expected level of development for the prime areas of learning PSED, C&L and PD.
